APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JANUARY 21, 2017 COUNCIL MEETING – DG Boettcher moved to approve the minutes of the January 21, 2017, Council Meeting, as electronically distributed. Seconded by DG Carnes and passed.

THIRD QUARTER FINANCIAL REPORT – DG Alcy Malkmus-Espinoza summarized the balance sheet for the third quarter, with a total of \$312,830.46 in Assets and in Liabilities and Capital. Council Chair Foster added that the report be placed on file for audit.

REPORTS – Council Chair Foster called for the first report. DG Carnes moved that a consent agenda be used, to accept all committee reports on the agenda and to move on to new business.
